

Recycling Program Update – December 2018

Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event

For 2018, we had 1,000 participants who utilized the program. We collected a total of 25,931 lbs. and 8,308 gallons of hazardous waste. We also collected a total of 880 lbs. pharmaceuticals.

Tours/Outreach

E-Waste

For the month of November we had approximately 266 residents, 8 non-profits, 16 businesses and 7 government agencies who utilize the program (297 total). 239 TVs and 262 computers came in for recycling in November.

Compost

We sold 31 compost bins at the holiday sale price of \$27.50.
